Program Name: Overnight Emergency Crisis Support
Hotel/Motel Vouchers for Emergency Overnight Housing

Value: Ranges from \$75 to \$200/night

Number Needed: 25/year.

Previous Donors: Century Hotel & Motel-6

Description: Approximately once or twice a month, patrol officers encounter individuals who need a place to go. Sometimes it is a domestic situation where no crime has been committed but the parties would benefit by being separated for a while. At times, they have nowhere else to go or there are no personal resources to pay for a motel or hotel.

The officer on the scene uses his/her discretion at the time to determine if the voucher is appropriate. If so, the officer will request a voucher from a shift supervisor. The officer may or may not have to transport the individual needing help. The shift supervisor will verify that there is space available and confirm a space at the facility. The officer also gives the individual contact information for Washington County resources.

TUCPF Program: Request donations or gift certificates/vouchers from local hotels and motels for official use from a team of Tualatin/Tigard/Wilsonville corridor facilities for in-kind donations. (Certificates may have restrictions to be available.)
